# Site Changes 2009

- Phase 1 COMPLETE: August 3, 2009
  - New database/account management
  - <http://auth.opensolaris.org>
  - Validate your account before November 3, 2009
- Phase 2: Target: Sept 09. Exact Date TBD
  - Transition to XWiki
- Phase 3: Target Date: TBD
  - Remaining client applications integrate with Auth
  - Details TBD

# Phase 2: Transition to XWiki

- General preparation
  - Review site feature map for a high level view of the changes
  - [http://opensolaris.org/os/community/web/restructuring/site\\_features/](http://opensolaris.org/os/community/web/restructuring/site_features/)
- Content preparation
  - Review content preparation detail
  - [http://opensolaris.org/os/community/web/restructuring/content\\_preparations/](http://opensolaris.org/os/community/web/restructuring/content_preparations/)
- Content work
  - Content owners: pre- and post-transition
  - Website team: pre- and post-transition

# Content Migration Process

- Content migrated Mon/Wed/Fri each week
- Snapshot of opensolaris.org content put on stage.opensolaris.org
- stage.opensolaris.org content converted/migrated to hub.opensolaris.org
- opensolaris.org => stage.os.org => hub.os.org
- Final snapshot on stage can be maintained for at least three months

# Content Migration Work

- Pre-transition: content owners
  - Evaluate content on hub
  - Compare hub to stage
  - Make changes ONLY on opensolaris.org
- XWiki Transition Sequence
- Post-transition: website team
  - Changes to support embedded media
- Post-transition: content owners
  - Check attachment links and that attachments are uploaded
  - Re-implement page anchors

# URL Redirects

- 1:1 mapping of migrated pages to new pages
- List will be pruned periodically to remove 404s and links with no hits to the destination page for 12 months.
- There will be no second redirect. If the page moves, it results in a 404.
- Additional links can be added on as-needed basis, if published in book or product README. However, teams should migrate any product links as soon as feasible after the transition.

# URL Hierarchy

- After P2 Transition: A modular Approach
  - Old portal app <http://opensolaris.org/os/> replaced by redirects to corresponding pages on <http://hub.opensolaris.org/>.
  - <http://opensolaris.org/jive> continues to run until Jive is replaced.
  - Tonic runs temporarily to service other apps not yet integrated with Auth. Also, name space reserved for potential use after tonic is decommissioned.
  - <http://opensolaris.org> & <http://www.opensolaris.org/> will redirect to <http://hub.opensolaris.org/> just as they currently redirect to the current portal at <http://opensolaris.org/os/>.
  - <http://auth.opensolaris.org/> used for log in and centralized account management for all applications.
  - <http://hub.opensolaris.org/> used for general information and community content for collectives on the XWiki system.
  - <http://xxxx.opensolaris.org/> used for the additional client apps.

# Final Thoughts

- We are moving to a new site with a new content management system, a new user management system, and a new architecture.
- The intention is to support open development and to provide flexibility for growth.
- As we move through these implementation phases, things will emerge over time – it can't all be built at once.
- The Phase 2 XWiki transition is not the end. More work on XWiki will be done and other applications to support open development.
